The Yowie Cup

Cup Overview:

The Yowie Cup is BACK!

Join us on **27th September 2025** for a cracking day of touch footy!

This year the Cup will start with round-robin games before progressing to a knockout comp later in the day.

It will consist of three divisions, Opens-Mixed (split into Cup and Plate), Under 18's Mixed. Team registration into The Yowie Cup is available to everyone!

Prize Money:

Divisional prize pools will be as per below:

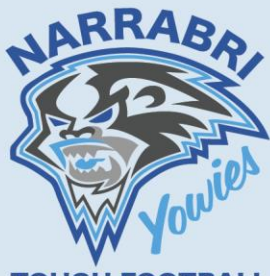
Opens Cup-	\$2500 winner, \$1000 runner up
Opens Plate -	\$1500 winner, \$500 runner up
Under 18 –	\$500 winner

Registration Details:

- Cost: \$250 per team (Opens) or \$150 per team (Under 18's)
- Registrations will be taken through MySideline and will close on 17th Sept 2025 (or once team allocations are exhausted)
- All teams are to be mixed teams (max. 3 males on field at a time)
- A maximum of 12 players can register per team (minimum of 6)
- Players can only be registered with one team. Each player needs to be registered into the team via MySideline. If the player has already paid the TFA fee of \$22 and the NSW Touch fee of \$30 for the 2025/26 financial year, there will be no extra cost to pay. If not, both these fees will be payable, totalling \$52 and will cover the player for future competitions in the 2025/26 financial year.
- Each team must supply one non-playing referee. The Referee cannot be used by more than one team.

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- Team shirts will need to be sourced by each team. Players must wear team shirt to play
- Each team in the Under 18's division will be given a bucket hat for each player.

General Information:

- Times – The Yowie Cup will run from 10am to 8pm (approximately)
- Games will run for 25mins with no half-time

Rules:

The round-robin draw will be created by Narrabri Touch Inc and before progressing into a traditional knockout format. The winner of each division will be the last team standing at the end of the day.

The standard TFA Edition 8 rules will be used for the duration of The Yowie Cup.

Where there is a tie at the end of a game, the win will be awarded to the team who scored the first try of the match.

To be eligible to play in the Under 18's division, players must be aged 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 or 17 and;

- Must have turned 12 on or before 1st September 2025 or
- Must not have turned 18 on or before 1st September 2025

To be eligible to play in the Opens division, players must have turned at least 18 on or before 1st September 2025. There is no maximum age limit.

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
